Putting the Patient at the Heart of Treatment

The hospital is strongly committed to the idea of "Patient-Centred Medicine", which focuses medical attention on the individual patient's needs and adapts treatment plans accordingly. The overarching goal of St Catherine's is to build trust and to provide the best, most advanced care to all patients.

Yet what distinguishes the hospital from its competitors is its principle of "integral healthcare", where experts in their fields take a multi disciplinary approach using the newest equipment and the latest treatment options to produce the best outcomes possible.

Patient safety and satisfaction are naturally top priorities, meaning staff go above and beyond to ensure the greatest levels of care at all times. As a result, St Catherine's has exceedingly high levels of patient satisfaction as well as one of the lowest infection rates (0.6%) in South Eastern Europe.

Research and Innovation

The physicians at the hospital are

affiliated with all four medical schools in Croatia while the hospital itself is a teaching hospital for the major universities and medical schools, and is licensed to carry out research in biomedicine.

St Catherine's is a driver of innovation and constantly seeks to push the boundaries of modern medicine in order to find the best possible treatments and ultimately improve patient outcomes.

For instance, the hospital is one of the few European institutions that started using applications of adiposederived mesenchymal stem cells (MSC) for cartilage repair.

While the hospital's orthopaedic team, were the first in the region to perform meniscal transplant surgery, an hour-long, outpatient, arthroscopic procedure that uses donor tissue to replace damaged meniscus, which can dramatically slow the onset of arthritis.

In addition, St Catherine's is currently applying a new biological treatment: meniscus replacement with a synthetic implant.

The hospital is revered for its exceptional sports medicine services and has treated over 200 top athletes from Croatia and beyond. It's also the official medical institution of the Croatian Olympic Committee and of the Croatian Football Federation.
